**We are offering a live review course for the FE Exam**

- Classes meet **Tuesday evenings, 7 to 10 P.M. in NSC 205**. The first class meets **Tuesday September 14, 2021**. The 12 review sessions will cover topics common to the civil, environmental and mechanical engineering FE exams such as: ethics, mathematics, probability and economics along with select topics relevant to the specific discipline.
- Registration fee is **\$250.00**, which includes **12 review sessions** and any instructor notes. Official FE study guide is extra, but not required.
- UB students passing the FE Exam before graduation will be reimbursed for their Intern Engineer Certificate (\$70 value), upon proof of obtaining their certificate.
